## **EXAM REMINDERS FOR STUDENTS**

It is hard to believe, but the end of the semester is almost here. Our teachers have worked extremely hard to prepare you over the course of the semester and you, as well, have put in the time and work to be successful. Here are a few important reminders as we continue to work toward being the top high school in North Carolina.

Our EOCs (Biology, English II, and Math I) and Civics & Economics exams will be taken on Tuesday, January 17th. The only students who need to be in attendance on January 17 are those students who are testing or those students who are aiming for perfect attendance. Once testing is complete, we will offer lunch and students will be allowed to leave for the day. However, our buses will not run their afternoon routes until 2:21pm. We will then give two exams per day on Wednesday January 18 (1st and 2nd block exams) and Thursday January 19 (3rd and 4th block exams). Testing each day will begin promptly at 7:30am each morning. After the first testing sessions, students will have an extended break to each lunch before the second exam session. Buses will dismiss each day at 2:21pm. Again, students who are aiming for perfect attendance must attend each day to receive credit for being present. If a student is in attendance during testing just for perfect attendance, they will report to the Auditorium and be allowed to leave after 10:45am. January 20th will serve as a make-up testing day and buses will also run at 2:21pm that afternoon.

Attendance is of the utmost importance on these days. If you are unable to attend during these days you need prior administrative approval. **You will NOT receive credit for the class if you do not sit for your exam.**

**The only students who are exempt from a non-EOC, non-VOCAT, non-State test are SENIORS WITH AN 'A' AVERAGE in the elective course.**

Please note that bus transportation will run on a normal schedule (2:21pm each day). There will not be a mid-day run, except to shuttle students to and from Woods. If, for example, you are a senior and have a first block exam and are exempt from your second block exam, you will need to find your own transportation home after 1st block ends. All students who are not in attendance January 17-20th will be marked "absent." But, this absence will not count toward their attendance requirement for the second semester at MHS.

### **IMPORTANT REMINDERS**

All Final Exams count as 20% of a student's final course grade. The exam can significantly improve final grades. Given our goal of becoming the top performing high school in North Carolina, each student plays an important role in achieving this goal. Students, please make sure over the next week that you are studying, catching up on assignments, and putting yourself in the best possible position going into final exams. Attend after school review sessions that are being provided by all subject areas! Exams will be here before we know it.
